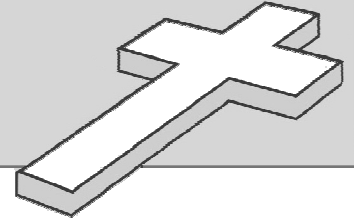

## From the Preacher's Desk Clint Davison

### My Hope Is Built On...

*"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead." (1 Peter 1:3 - NKJV)*

As we turn the page on a new year many are searching for clarity, searching for The Answer, searching for hope. There is so much uncertainty and unrest in the world around us. People want to have something solid and sure onto which they can hold. However, for most people that security is money or power or even health...all temporal things. As Peter writes in the verse above, the Christian has a "living" hope – a hope beyond a big checking account or big office or anything else this world can offer. Our hope is for eternal life with God in Heaven based on the resurrection of Christ from the dead. Since He rose, our destiny is certain, for *"...now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep"* (1 Cor 15:20).

A hymn we often sing, "My Hope is Built on Nothing Less," reminds us of this truth: "My hope is built on nothing less than Jesus' blood and righteousness. I dare not trust the sweetest frame, but wholly lean on Jesus' name." This song reminds us of a "big picture" truth – God created mankind for a perfect, lasting fellowship with Him. To accomplish that, He demonstrated His love and graciously provided all we could ever want or

need! Our reliance simply has to be in Christ! Our trust isn't in the Oval Office...or the corner office. Our hope isn't grounded in man or even in self. Our God has provided the Cornerstone upon whom our faith, our hope, our confidence can be placed.

But, one thing we can absolutely know: *"Christ died for our sins...and rose again"* (1 Cor 15:3-4).
