Healthy Living

Over the past few months, for a variety of reasons, I have become more and more interested in health and nutrition – not the least of those reasons being I see the big Five-Oh sneaking up on me! We have always been pretty healthy eaters. Kara has always done a fabulous job of making sure we eat well-balanced, nutritious (and incredibly tasty) meals. But, as I've read and researched more and more, I've realized there's much more to really being healthy than just not gorging on Big Mac's – sorry McDonald's. I've realized it's not only important to monitor your intake, but it matters *how* I eat, *when* I eat, and what I do when I'm *not* eating. In other words, my intake matters just as much as my exercise. But, they're both vital to truly being healthy.

Do you notice a spiritual parallel there?

I doubt any of us would disagree with the fact we absolutely need to know our Bibles. But, let's make the parallel. We have to watch all our intake! A spoonful of Bible once or twice a week is not going to counteract Super-Size portions of the junk TV, movies and video games dump down our throats. We need to be people who indulge in God's Word, people who feast on His precepts and encouragements. When times are tough, we

don't go to worldly counsel – we go to God Himself! We have to know how to "*rightly handle*" God's Word and remember it, and only it, can equip us "*for every good work*" (2 Tim 2:15, 3:16-17).

With that in mind, let's continue the comparison: We also have to make sure we're doing more than just coming on Sundays (and an occasional Wednesday) to just sit in the "spiritual gym." Realizing, through really getting to know God's Word, we are equipped for every good work, we then have to go do them! Good works are part of who
