### Have You Made Your Reservation?

There is nothing worse than arriving at any one of the aforementioned only to have the receptionist or counter person say, "Have you made a reservation?" When you say "yes", they say they have no record; too late, the seat, table or room has been given to someone else. Talk about frustrating! Reservations are important if you want a seat on an airplane, table in a restaurant, or room at a hotel after a long day of traveling. There is no better feeling than knowing that you have a reservation when you pullup, but it takes some planning and forethought. 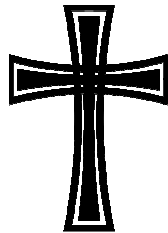
