## Scar Stories

Scar stories. I'm guessing everyone in this congregation has one, if not several. Some of the stories are painful, others are funny. Some are significant, while others, less so. Yet without exception, every scar serves as a reminder whether visible or invisible of wounds we've incurred. The other day I found myself looking down at my hands and the scars on them, some I have had most my life; On my left hand alone I have three fairly large scars and each scar has a story about how it got there and what I was doing when I got it. Those four scars got me to thinking about the other 12 scars on my body, also with a story. Each of those scars came with some physical pain and almost all of them are a result of some thoughtless act. When I think of these outwardly visible scars, they don't just remind me of thoughtlessness, they also remind me to be more careful and thoughtful about my actions and that actions have consequences.

But I have a lot more scars than just those that are outwardly visible. I am talking about the scars left behind by my sin that most of you will never see. However, these scars though unseen and hidden from human eyes are often the most painful. They are emotional and spiritual scars that we all have that are the consequence of our thoughts, words and actions. Someone has said, "We

live with the scars we choose." But we don't have too spiritually speaking.

There is one who knows and has seen all our scars caused by our thoughtless and sometimes well thought out sinful actions and yet is able to see the best in us and past the sin that has marred our lives. You see, He too has scars and it was by his scars that we are healed. "Surely our griefs He Himself bore, And our sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, Smitten of

## Spring Senior Saints' Dinner

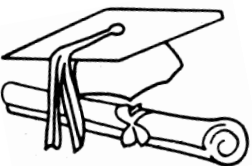

## LBC—Summer Session

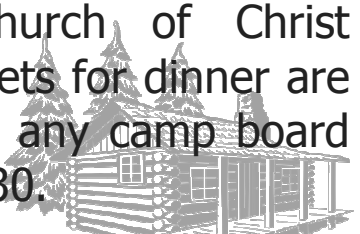

God, and afflicted. <sup>5</sup> But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed. <sup>6</sup> All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To fall on Him.” (Isa. 53:4-6 NAU) How can scars, formed only by pain, be full of hope? In our Christian faith, hope is symbolized by the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. He bore our sins in His body on the cross and has the scars to prove it. His scar story is really the only one that counts, because by His scars we have been set free from the condemnation of our actions. (cf. Romans 8:1ff)
