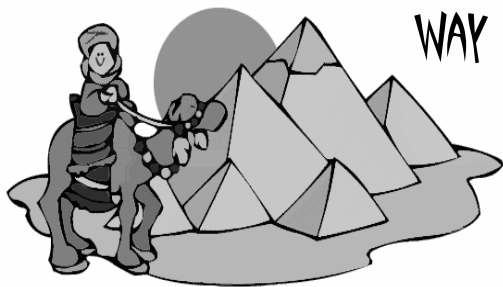
July will bring church camps for both pre-teens and teens, as well as our Mountain States Children's Home mission effort the 8th -14th...more information to come.
