Mayonnaise People

I don't normally do this, but a brother shared with me an article that he had put together that had a pretty good message. So I have taken some license and adapted it to this week's article, but the body of the message is his, I thought you might enjoy it.

Putting vinegar and oil dressing on a salad requires a brisk shake to combine the ingredients, but when the bottle is set down the contents again separate. You see, oil and vinegar, like oil and water just do not mix. In relationships sometimes there are oil people and vinegar people. They may work together for a time, but always end up as individuals that separate and are ineffective in working together.

Take for instance the church that began on the day of Pentecost, over 3000 were baptized for the remission of their sins, but that didn't mean that they changed all at once in terms of personality and ethnicity. Luke records for us in Acts 1:7-11 that nineteen segments of society from around the known world heard the first gospel sermon and many of them became Christians. Now you

know there had to be some oil and water in that group of people, kind of like Linder Road is a mixture of Christians from all over the United States.

Well, the French found a solution to the problem with vinegar and oil. By adding egg yolk and mixing vigorously they formed mayonnaise. Mayonnaise was a stable sauce that kept the vinegar and oil in an emulsion and combined the flavor of the contents.

If we find ourselves struggling to work with people that we are not compatible with, we might take a hint from the French and their mayonnaise. If we

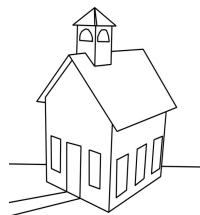
