Bridges That Last

Well, the Holiday season is over along with all the Holiday movies, but there is one that has longer legs than others, the Holiday hit Movie -- "It's a Wonderful Life." Remember how George Bailey, from the time he was a boy, really wanted to make a name for himself and had all these great dreams of how he was going to impact the world?

In one of the scenes of the movie George says to Mary, "*Mary, I know what I'm going to do tomorrow and the next day and the next year and the year after that. I'm going to leave this little town far behind, and I'm going to see the world. Italy, Greece, the Parthenon, the Colosseum. Then I'm coming back here, and I'll go to college and see what they know, and then I'm going to build things. I'm going to build air fields. I'm going to build skyscrapers a hundred stories high. I'm going to build BRIDGES a mile long.*" Did you hear that, "...I'm going to build bridges a mile long...?"

Of course, we know that George Bailey despite his boasts, didn't build any of those things – he didn't travel the world, he didn't go to college and he didn't build any mile-long bridges that would span a huge gorge!! And because he didn't do any of those things, he felt like he was a failure, and that is why he finds himself standing on a bridge in the movie considering suicide.

But we know from the movie that he was anything but a failure, though he was not known for building huge structures. His life had been spent in building bridges of much greater importance. He built all kinds

of bridges in the lives in the community of Bedford Falls, he built bridges within his relationships, his marriage and children, with his mother and brother and the many friends he had. He had to be shown from the weirdest of circumstances that he had built bridges that were far longer, wider, and deeper than he could physically see until his eyes, were opened to reality. He may not have been renowned by the physical bridges he might have built, but he was known by those who mattered most that he had connected to and in so doing had become the richest man in Bedford Falls.
