IT SEEMS TO ME

There are things in this life that people tend to shy away from. One is political debate. Nobody wants to talk about politics because it always leads to heated discussion that ends up in voices raised and feelings hurt. Another reason we tend to avoid those discussions is that to be effective in presenting your political view you really need to be well versed on what it is that you are discussing – politics. And not too many people desire to know enough about the issues to present a clear and persuasive argument for their belief.

The other thing that people don't want to talk about is the Bible or religion. Don't you hear people say that they have their own belief and you have yours so let's just get along? What they are really saying is that my belief is different than yours but don't ask me to give a clear statement of what I believe because I really don't know. Most people don't know why they believe what they believe or what their denomination believes in. Question, do you know why you believe what you believe or why you practice what you practice? For instance, do you know why baptism is necessary for salvation? If someone were to ask you, would you be able to give them a Bible answer? You had better be able since you have been commanded to go and make disciples (Matthew 28:19) and to fail to do so is a sin. If someone were to ask you a question about death other than it is a physiological fact, could you give an answer? Could you give a definitive answer to what Christian Character looks like? How about this one, if someone were to ask you

what's the value of studying the book of Malachi, could you? If the answer to the last three questions is no, then you need to be in Bible class on Sunday morning and Wednesday evening. (2 Timothy 2:15; 1 Peter 3:15)

Since faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God (Romans 10:17), **it seems to me** that every Christian should love to attend Bible study. Our Bible classes should be just as full as our worship services. The truth, however, is that in most local churches some people just do not come out for Bible study. On Sunday morning they feel like the assembling does not get started until the worship service that includes the Lord's

For most, however, absenteeism does give an impression of a lack of commitment to Christ, an overall lack of interest in the Word of God and spiritual things, and to the body of Christ. It would be wonderful if, at least on Sunday mornings, we had just as many attending Bible study as we do in the worship service. A little drop off on Wednesday nights is understandable because some are not able to get out at night, but there is no legitimate reason (other than those mentioned above), so far as I can see, for Christians not to come out an hour earlier on Sunday morning to study the Word of God. Let me encourage you to support our congregation by being at services every time there is a Bible study going on. You will not regret it. Next week I will give you some reasons why Bible study is profitable to you.
