### **Jesus' Unchangeable Purpose**

Last weekend people all over the world celebrated the resurrection of Jesus! His resurrection, however, is more than an event that impacts us one time each year. In fact, as New Testament Christians, Jesus, instituted a memorial in the Lord's Supper that allows us to remember the totality of Jesus' life every first day of the week. The impact of Jesus' resurrection is an event that changed the course of history. It is an event that could and should impact our daily lives. But how?

Well, because Jesus lives, His purpose is unchangeable. Jesus said, I didn't come into the world to condemn the world; I came into the world to save the world. (John 3:16-17) You see, Jesus didn't come to make us feel guilty, He didn't come to condemn us, He didn't come to heap on guilt, and blame, and shame. No, Jesus said He came to take those things off our shoulders. The Jewish leaders (Pharisees) loaded the people down with plenty of those feelings and burdened the people down. Matthew records Jesus' reaction to people with such burdens as those who were distressed and downcast like sheep without a shepherd (Matthew 9:36). Later on, in the same gospel, Matthew records Jesus' words to people feeling the burdens of life and sin, "*Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest.*"<sup>29</sup> "*Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart; and you shall find rest for your souls.*"<sup>30</sup> "*For My yoke is easy, and My load is light*" (Matt. 11:28-30 NAS). You see, Jesus came to relieve us of guilt and to forgive sin,

to show real life, and to show we could have a new beginning.

However, the new beginning is not to be entered into without sitting down and seriously considering the cost of being a disciple of Jesus. Jesus is not looking for a following. He is not looking for fans. He is looking for those who are willing to leave whatever is necessary behind to follow as true disciples in exchange for experiencing the abundant life both now and beyond this life. Jesus' purpose is unchangeable; however, He demands that we make changes to follow

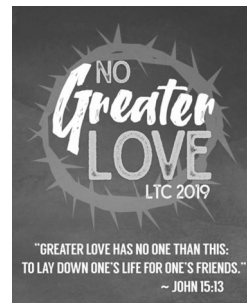
