Humble Nobility

"Servant" in our English New Testament usually represents the Greek word *doulos* and is often translated as bond slave or bondservant. A bondservant back then was one who was either purchased or one who sold himself as an indentured servant to another in order to pay off a debt or some such thing. Either way, by doing so a person is no longer at his own disposal but is his master's property. Bought to serve his master's needs, to be at his beck and call every moment. In other words, the bondservant's sole business is to do his master's bidding. Christian service therefore means, first and foremost, living out a servant relationship to one's Savior (1 Corinthians. 6:19-20). In terms of being a bondservant of the Lord, the relationship, being a servant carries the idea of humble nobility, thus, being God's servant is an honorable position.

What work does Christ set his servants to do? The way that they serve Him, He tells them, is by becoming the slaves of their fellow-servants and being willing to do literally anything, however costly, irksome, or undignified, in order to help them. This is what love means, as He himself showed at the Last supper when he played the slave's part and washed the disciples' feet stating that they were to follow His example of serving one another.

When the New Testament speaks of ministering to the saints, it carries the idea of devoting time, effort, and substance to giving them all the practical help possible. The essence of Christian service is loyalty to the

king expressing itself in care for his servants (Matthew 25: 31-46).

The question I suppose we are to ask ourselves is, "Who do we serve?" John Kenneth Galbraith, in his autobiography, *A Life in Our Times*, illustrates the devotion of Emily Gloria Wilson, his family's housekeeper: It had been a wearying day, and I asked Emily to hold all telephone calls while I had a nap. Shortly thereafter the phone rang. Lyndon Johnson was calling from the White House. "Get me Ken Galbraith. This is Lyndon Johnson." "He is sleeping, Mr. Presi
