**Church Camp**

My first experience with church camp was in the late 70s at Camp Takatoka near Talequah, OK. (And yes, both of those are spelled correctly!) I was in the youngest group of kids. But I'll never forget – two older guys, both named Tim, took me in and made me feel welcomed. I'll always have fond memories of Takatoka, and of Pettijohn Springs, and of Burnt Cabin, and, most recently, of Camp Ivydale.

Summer church camps are special places. However, I would venture none is more special to me than Camp Ivydale. For the past 13 years I've been blessed to serve as a speaker at Teen Camp. For most of those years we've been there as a family. Great memories. Great times.

This congregation invests a great deal of time, manpower, and money into Camp Ivydale. The volunteer hours alone are priceless. Why do we do that? Why have our elders seen fit to invest the finances and the effort into a place we don't even own?

Kids. That's why. Kids who grow into young Christian men and women and for the remainder of their lives will carry memories of fun times, spiritual growth, and dear friends.

This week (9<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup>) was Pre-Teen Camp. Many of our kids are there as both campers and counselors. The week of the 21<sup>st</sup> is Teen Camp. Many kids and adults will be at Ivydale that week. It will be warm. It will be tiring. It will test some of our folks' patience. It will **all** be worth it! Jesus said, in Matthew 18:3-4, "...unless you turn and become like

*children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Therefore, whoever humbles himself like this child - this one is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven"* (CSB). We see in children – I'll even count teen-agers! – a sincerity, a humility sometimes missing in older folks. They understand their dependence on parents or older adults. That, I believe was our Savior's point: those who truly understand how very much they need saving are those in the Kingdom. We also see in kids a beautiful forgiving spirit. At camp we'll see a couple kids in a dispute over an issue, then

later they're hanging out together. Kids don't often carry grudges. They argue, get over it, and move on. Our children also can be a great example of trusting. Many times, kids I've just met have shared their hearts with me and others at camp. Kids trust parents to provide. They place confidence in the adults around them – until proven otherwise. Again, it's a great message for all of us about our relationship with God. We can have great confidence in our Lord – and He's NEVER going to let us down.

So, if your kids (or you) are off to camp, or just returned, talk to them about their experience. Relate to them how great it is that they're blessed to have a place to go experience spiritual growth and encouragement. However, then remind them that's always available in Christ's body – the church. Camp is great – but the church is always with us, and God is forever to be trusted and will always provide.
