**He Showed Us the Father**

*"All things have been entrusted to me by my Father. No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son desires to reveal him"*(Matthew 11:27 – CSB).

I want to know God, don't you? I want to know who He is, what He thinks, and what He expects of me. By God's grace, we are introduced to Him in the most perfect way possible! As God in the flesh, Jesus discloses God to us in a manner which bests any other means of revelation. God spoke in a variety of ways in the past (Hebrews 1:1-3), but it was in His Son God revealed Himself fully. He came and lived here – on this earth – and essentially said, "World, meet God!" It's amazing. The apostle John wrote, *"No one has ever seen God. The one and only Son, who is himself God and is at the Father's side he has revealed him"*(John 1:18). In Jesus – the Word, the *Logos* – God was presenting Himself in a language humanity can understand.

But God didn't divulge Himself to us so we might simply have a better intellectual understanding of Him. He wanted us to know we can trust Him! When Adam and Eve sinned, it was because Satan had broken their confidence in God, right? They were willing to set aside His will to attain something about which they decided God tricked them! If the corruption of sin is to be repaired in us, we must learn to trust God. And that's the beauty of it all: in Jesus Christ, we see God can indeed be trusted. He can be

counted on to die for us rather than leave us hanging in sin! Paul wrote, *"He did not even spare his own Son but offered him up for us all. How will he not also with him grant us everything?"*(Romans 8:32).

However, let's not be naive about this. God didn't show Himself to be reliable just so we can sleep better at night. Yes, the display of God's perfect power and love leads us to trust Him. But we see we can trust Him, which *should* lead us to obey Him. *"You are my friends,"* Jesus said, *"if you do what I command you"*(John 15:14). In Jesus, God
