Help from Above

Some of you might remember several years ago (summer of 2002) there were nine miners trapped in a four foot high shaft 240 feet underground for seventy-seven excruciating hours (three days) at the Quecreek mine in Pennsylvania. The miners inadvertently drilled into an abandoned shaft filled with water that flooded their own shaft with 50-60 million gallons of water trapping them in the dark below ground. One of the miners said that it was an incredible test of faith. The story had a happy ending in that all nine were rescued. According to one of the miners, they helped each other. When the 55 degree water they were in started to get to one of them, all of the others would huddle up next to the one to get him warm, and when another got cold, the favor was returned. He went on to say that when one would start to break down mentally, the others would all rally to bolster him up, and likewise, it would be returned when needed. He said they learned how to rely on each other like never before, and they began to trust each other with their very lives. And when they had done all they could for each other, help came from above and they were rescued.

Have you ever felt trapped and pressured like those miners? I'm talking about the pressures of schoolwork, a job, family pressures, or anything else. Have you felt like yelling, "I can't do this anymore!" If so, that is the exact moment you

need to call out to our Father above, who is the God of all comfort (2 Corinthians 1:3-11), and say, "I can't do this anymore – without You, Lord!" During life's pressure, it is of crucial importance that we remember what Jesus told us in Matthew 11:28. "Come to Me, all you who are weary and, burdened, and I will give you rest." I'm talking about help from above. And don't forget that there are others like
