Hang On!

"There is a morbid theme running through the music of Johnny Cash...He has songs about soldiers killed in Vietnam, songs about dying cowboys on the streets of Laredo...songs about tragedy and war. Famously, he performed almost his entire career dressed in black – like he was on his way to a funeral. So, it's not a stretch to think he might have been a bit preoccupied with the idea of mortality...Cash explained this was the wrong way to see it: 'I am not obsessed with death. I'm obsessed with living. The battle against the Dark One and the clinging to the right one is what my life is about'"(dailystoic.com).

No, this is not an article about Johnny Cash. But I read this quote and was caught by his statement, "clinging to the right one is what my life is all about." I'm not going to make a judgment about The Man in Black's spiritual condition. However, his point about clinging to the "right one" is fabulous! In Sunday morning's lesson we're going to discuss a well-known, yet little discussed character who was recorded as clinging to Jesus. Sunday evening we'll talk about the great lyric, "I will cling to the old rugged cross."

Forgive my poor grammar here, but, as Christians, what do we hang on to? First, we absolutely must, as our Sunday morning character will show us, hang on to Jesus! He's Mr. Cash's "right one!" There are many aspects of our faith: our worship, our church leadership, etc. All of these must be treated as important – vital to our Christianity. Why?

Because they all stem from Jesus' teaching and from His sacrificing His life for His body, the church (Colossians 1:18).

Secondly, we also need to cling to that old rugged cross. As previously stated, we must remember the importance of doctrine – the teaching of Jesus and His apostles and of the inspired Bible writers. That being said, let's never lose sight of the tragic beauty, and incredible meaning, of the cross of Calvary. Let's never become complacent toward the pain and suffering of the sinless Son of God on that cross.

Finally – no musical reference for this one – we need to cling to one another. The phrase “one another” is used dozens of times in the New Testament to encourage and remind us: we’re not in this alone! We need each other. We need to recognize, promote and nurture this Christian family. Wait, here’s a musical reference – “Bind Us Together.” Our prayer should be that God binds us together with cords that cannot be broken.

In this “battle against the Dark One” we must hang on! Cling to the right One. Hold on tightly to His cross. And, to face this battle, let’s make sure we’re tightly bound together! That’s what our lives should be about.
