WITNESS JESUS

Over the years, you no doubt have viewed court trials where several individuals have been called to give testimony to what they may or may not have seen, heard or experienced regarding discovering the truth in a court case. Such people are called witnesses. Some trials are based on circumstantial evidence; if you have enough, the judge or jury can find a person guilty or acquit them. I'm told that such cases are more difficult to adjudicate than say a case that is based on an eyewitness account. On the strength of a single eye witness a person can be found guilty or innocent. But what if you had several credible witnesses? In such cases the truth is even more sure to come out. You see, both the judge and the jury are interested in discovering the truth.

Merriam Webster defined a witness as one who can certify, attest, vouch or testify to the truth or genuineness of something. A witness is one that could give a firsthand account of something they have seen, heard, or experienced.

When Jesus our Lord walked among us, He did not do so in secret, but in the broad daylight for all mankind to witness. From his birth in a manger to His ascending into the clouds, men and women witnessed firsthand the most incredible person to ever walk among humanity. People, both friend and foe, heard his teachings, saw His miracles (signs and wonders), death on the cross and resurrection from the dead. They also experienced His love, compassion and forgiveness. That was almost 2000 years ago, but we have the eyewitness records of those

who heard, saw and experienced Jesus Christ, the Son of God. John the Apostle said it succinctly, *"What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we beheld and our hands handled, concerning the Word of Life-- and the life was manifested, and we have seen and bear witness and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was manifested to us-- what we have*
