CONFIRMED OR STANDBY

Some of you may or may not know that Lori and I, when flying most places, fly standby. Which means that after all those who have purchased a confirmed seat are on the plane, if there are any seats left and we are high enough on the standby list we will be seated, if not, too bad. Now, the interesting thing about flying in this manner which we have done several times, you really can tell a marked difference in the actions and attitudes of those who have confirmed seats/tickets and those who don't and are flying standby.

The ones with confirmed tickets read newspapers, chat with their friends or sleep. They are not concerned in the least of not making it on the airplane. However, the ones on standby hang around the ticket counter (not supposed to), pace, are constantly looking at the list on the header behind the flight attendant at the desk, and then pace and look, look and pace some more. Why the difference? Well, the difference is caused by a confidence factor. Those with confirmed tickets are confident they will get on, those with standby tickets, not so much. You see, there is something comforting and peaceful about knowing you are going to make it on the plane.

How about this question, if you knew that in fifteen minutes you would have to stand in judgment before the Holy God and learn your eternal destiny, what would your reaction be? Would you restlessly fidget, look around and pace saying to yourself, "I don't know what God's going to say, will it be 'Welcome home, child,' or will it be 'Depart

from me; I never knew you?" Such uncertainty is spiritually flying on standby.

On the other hand, we can confidently rest in full assurance that we will make it to heaven. How can we have such confidence you might ask? Our confidence rests in what God has done for us. God has given us His Son, who died for our sins, and He has testified in His own Word that if we trust in Jesus' redemptive work on the cross our seat has been confirmed, better than that, our dwelling place has been reserved as well.
