



## Lesson Three – Your State in the World (1 John 2:12-17) Addendum – Vs 18-23

### Let's Get Started

- ⊕ "Antichrist" has been corrupted and morphed into a nonsensical term almost. What do you think of immediately?
  - \* The reality of this term is very different...and very ever-present in our culture.
  - \* As we get into John's words, think of examples of anti-Christ's in our society.

### Into the Text

- ⊕ Watch Out For Deceivers! – 2:18-23
  - \* Notice, we're back to "\_\_\_\_\_." It's PAIDIA again.
  - \* The "last hour" is not "\_\_\_\_\_" – it's "\_\_\_\_\_" – it's our age.
  - \* This is a term only used by \_\_\_\_\_.
    - This is not the "\_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_."
    - Anyone who \_\_\_\_\_ Christ is an anti-Christ!
  - \* They "\_\_\_\_\_ \_\_\_\_\_" – they were there...and left!
    - He seems to be saying they're not \_\_\_\_\_ in their views.
    - They "went out" of the \_\_\_\_\_.
  - \* Vs 20 – tough passage, but don't get too bogged down in the "\_\_\_\_\_."
    - Seems to be the application of \_\_\_\_\_.
    - Regardless, the point is – they have everything they need for \_\_\_\_\_!
  - \* It is IMPOSSIBLE to \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus and still abide with God.

### Apply It

- ⊕ John is apparently also dealing with a "gospel of self-satisfaction" in his day.
  - Do we face this obstacle? How?
  - How does this tie in with an "anti-Christ"?
- ⊕ Point blank: Do we hold a Biblical view of Jesus as a litmus test for fellowship?
